BANGLADESH INSTITUTE OF ARCHITECTS RECOMMENDS KEY CHANGES TO ECPS





The Electronic Construction Permitting System (ECPS) recently launched by the Capital Development Authority (RAJUK) has received recommendations from the Institute of Architects Bangladesh (IAB). In a workshop held on March 16, 2023, IAB, in collaboration with RAJUK, discussed crucial aspects of ECPS.

One significant proposal from IAB suggests introducing a "Provisional Architectural Approval" step between "Land Use Clearance (LUC)" and "Construction Permit (CP)" to prevent redundant re-submissions in case of CP rejection.

IAB emphasized the role of the architect as the main coordinator throughout the project but called for a clear delineation of responsibilities. They also suggested maintaining a "Rejection Database" to list reasons for design and permit rejections and a mechanism for reporting unclear rejections.

The recommendations advocate reducing manual interventions and ensuring digital signatures for accountability, while also providing specific guidelines on various aspects, such as drawing size, project naming, and passwords.

IAB expressed its willingness to support RAJUK in implementing these changes, highlighting the importance of professional guidance and control. The proposed modifications aim to streamline the ECPS process, making it more accessible and efficient for architects and consultants while maintaining high standards of design and construction.

PROMOTING FIRE SAFETY AND STRUCTURAL INTEGRITY A VISIT TO DHAKA MEDICAL

A VISIT TO DHAKA MEDICAL COLLEGE HOSPITAL



On March 29, 2023, Ar. Prof. Dr. Khandaker Shabbir Ahmed and Major (Retd.) AKM Shakeel Nawaz attended an online session about "Hospitals at Risk of Fire or Earth quake" hosted by Ekattor TV. They discussed fire safety and structural issues, based on their visit to Dhaka Medical College.

On March 27, 2023, a delegation from the Fire Service & National Security Agency visited Dhaka Medical College Hospital and identified fire safety risks and structural deficiencies in aging buildings.

Ar. Prof. Dr. Khandaker Shabbir Ahmed, who is also the President of IAB, emphasized the need for integrated management to ensure that structural defects do not compromise fire safety. He suggested that retrofitting is possible with the right approach and management. Dr. Ahmed stressed the need for building and facility management authorities in Dhaka. These authorities would ensure safer and better-functioning buildings under regulation oversight. Buildings in Dhaka are often repurposed to meet market demand. However, conversion requires a "closed loop" approach with a responsible authority ensuring safety, integrity, and compliance.

Dr. Ahmed proposes conducting architectural audits to identify limitations before approving new

IAB's Proactive Approach to Address the Implications of Detail Area Plan (2022-35) In the wake of the enforcement of the Detail Area Plan (DAP 2022-35) in August 2022, addressing the consequences and fostering positive engagement with relevant stakeholders and agencies became a top priority for the 25th Executive Council (EC) of the Institute of Architects Bangladesh (IAB). This endeavor highlights the collective dedication of IAB in safeguarding the architectural profession and its continuous pursuit of excellence.

100 HOMES: COMMITMENT TO SOCIETY

The Institute of Architects Bangladesh (IAB), after years of being a respected professional organization, is taking a transformative step to address the housing needs of the rural poor in the country. Despite architects' significant contributions, many primarily serve the elite class, leaving the majority of the population underserved. This disregard for the housing and architecture of 90% of the population has seeped into institutional policies and university curriculam. technical support, and hands-on learning opportunities for students. In addition to architects, other technical professionals will also play a vital role in ensuring the Hundred Homes for Rural Poor project's success.

This community-based initiative strives to design and build sustainable, affordable housing for low-income families, reinforcing architects' social responsibility and dedication to the welfare of the underprivileged. STRENGTHENING BANGLADESH'S BUILDING RESILIENCE A LEAP IN RETROFITTING TECHNOLOGY

In a crucial step toward fortifying Bangladesh's infrastructure against seismic threats, the Institute of Architects
Bangladesh facilitated a two-day e-training program on Seismic Retrofitting Technology from January 27 to 28, 2023 with a Retrofitting Technology Dissemination Project in Bangladesh (RDBP).

Urgency in Seismic Preparedness:

Japanese trainers from the Retrofit Expert Team (RET) brought their profound knowledge to the training. Their insights, combined with local efforts, empower Bangladesh to enhance its infrastructure's resilience.

This e-training program lays a crucial foundation for Bangladesh's journey toward seismic preparedness. By embracing seismic retrofitting, we fortify our cities, protect lives, and safeguard our infrastructure. Together, we build a safer and more resilient Bangladesh.

ENHANCING FIRE SAFETY AWARENESS IN BANGLADESH THROUGH EXPERT TRAINING

- •Promoting compliance with the Bangladesh National Building Code (BNBC) fire safety



REDISCOVERING HISTORY

THE RESTORATION OF MUGHAL HAMMAM KHANA



In 22 March 2021, a remarkable journey began—the restoration of the Mughal Hammam Khana at the Lalbagh Fort in Old Dhaka. Funded by the US Ambassadors Fund for Cultural Preservation (AFCP), this project was a testament to the commitment to preserving Bangladesh's rich heritage and celebrating its milestones.

A Historical Treasure:

The Mughal Hammam Khana, dating back to the 17th century, is one of the primary structures within the Lalbagh Fort complex. Its historical significance cannot be overstated, and its restoration was a labor of love and dedication.

The US Ambassadors Fund for Cultural Preservation (AFCP) is a beacon of cultural preservation worldwide. This initiative received a grant of \$185,933 (Tk2 crore) to restore and

architecturally document the Hammam Khana, making it accessible to the public once more.

The project was initiated to mark multiple jubilees: Bangladesh's 50th year of independence, the centenary of the Father of the Nation, Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, and the golden jubilee of US-Bangladesh friendship. It was a symbol of collaboration and cultural celebration.

Before the restoration, the beauty of the Hammam Khana was hidden beneath layers of botched restoration efforts. Original crafts and designs lay concealed behind plaster and concrete. This project sought not only to restore but also to open up the second floor to the public after years of being sealed.

The restoration journey spanned two years, culminating in a grand

closing ceremony on March 22, 2023. US Ambassador to Bangladesh Peter Haas and State Minister for Cultural Affairs KM Khalid, MP, unveiled the restored Hammam Khana, breathing new life into this historical treasure.

This monumental endeavor was made possible through the dedication of Project Director Chandan Kumar Dey and the expertise of project consultants Dr. Abu Sayeed M. Ahmed, Dr. T M J Nilan Cooray (conservation architect), and Dr. AK M Shahnawaz (Medieval specialist). The restoration of the Mughal Hammam Khana stands as a testament to the commitment to preserving cultural heritage for future generations and celebrating the rich history of Bangladesh.

A PARTNERSHIP WITH NBR

Their primary objective is to establish an effective partnership between the National Board of Revenue (NBR) and IAB for fair tax collection on government-related matters. This meeting was held at National Board of Revenue (NBR), Agargaon.

In the discussion on behalf of IAB, the Task Force Chairman Ar. Md. Anwar Hossain, members Ar. Khan Md. Mahfuzul Huq (Vice- President, International Relations) Ar. Nurur Rahman Khan, Ar. Mohammad

Foyez Ullah, the Task Force Member-Secretary Ar. Mir Md. Naian Sakib (Treasurer, IAB) participated in the discussion. IAB and its members recognize their role as responsible citizens and aim to abide by government laws and regulations, contributing to the nation's prosperity.

Bangladeshi architects have achieved international recognition for their modern, sustainable, safe, and aesthetically pleasing designs, playing a leadership role in promoting these values worldwide.

Architects are crucial in ensuring that all constructions adhere to

modern, safe, and environmentally friendly standards, addressing challenges posed by natural disasters and urbanization.

Challenges with Current Taxation Architects currently face a 15% VAT and a 10% advance income tax. IAB proposes reducing the VAT rate to 5% or 7.5% and a reduced income tax, encouraging legitimate financial channels and boosting government revenue.

A Collaborative Approach IAB seeks to facilitate taxation training for architects and form a joint task force with NBR representatives to devise a collective revenue collection strategy. The collaboration aims to establish a balanced taxation system that benefits both architects and the nation's development.
